Community Engagement Giving - Organizations seeking funding for programs outside of those listed in Focused Giving, and whose programs focus on the unmet needs of underserved low-income populations, can apply in cycles 3 and 4 only. *Examples of programs in Community Engagement Giving: education, health care access and other human services programs.*
