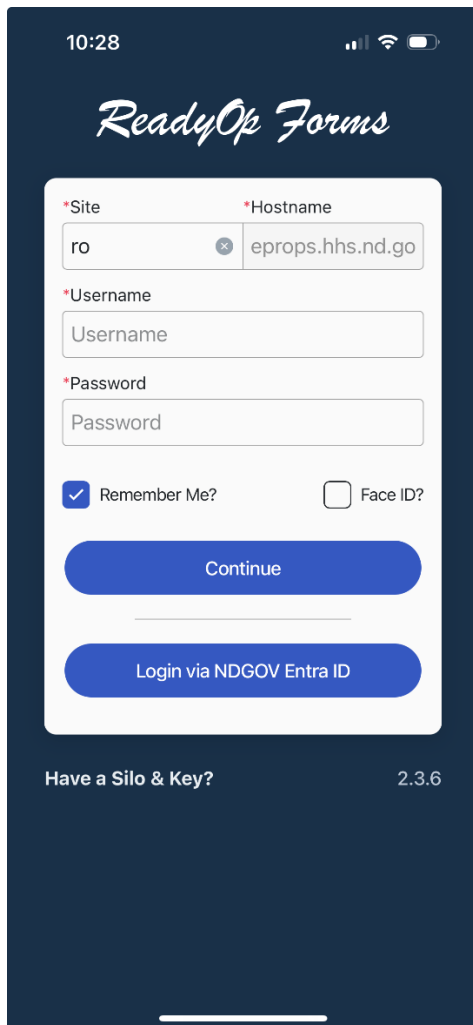

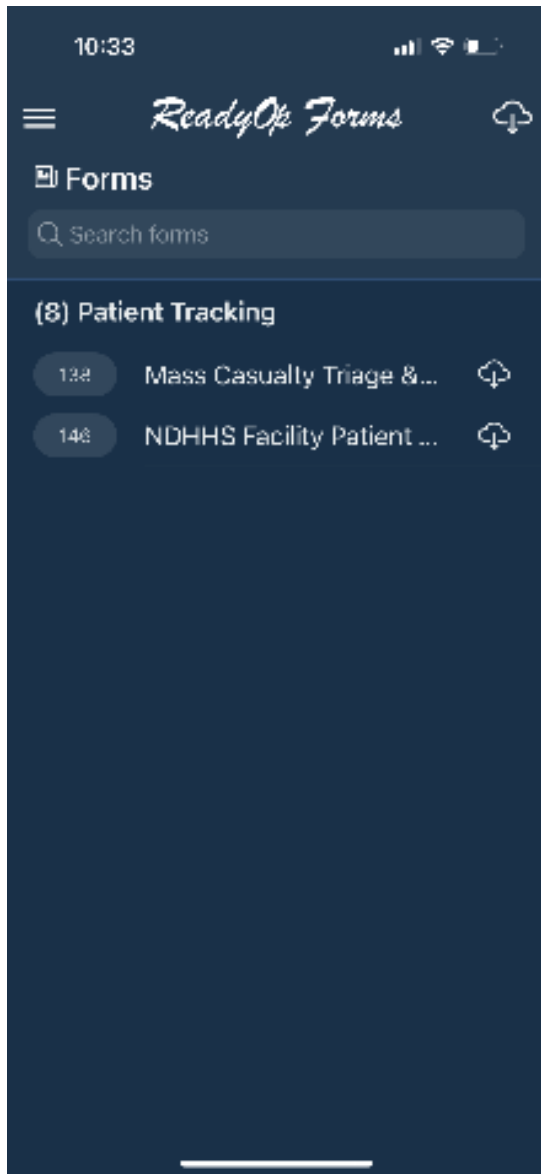

NDHHS Mass Casualty Triage & Tracking
