Additional consideration

- AHCA/NCAL Quality Award (Baldrige Framework)
- Facilities that have 30% or more residents with an SMI diagnosis

All data for QM are from CMS Care Compare.

- Program follows the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) October 1 September 30
- Data point used are the fourth-quarter average at the end of the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY)
- No reporting requirements for NF that have required data published by CMS

ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

AHCA/NCAL QUALITY AWARD

- A national recognition for performance excellence.
- Building program beginning with Bronze, then Silver, then Gold awards.
- Award must be active during the program FFY
 - Bronze and silver awards are active for 3 years. Gold for 5 year.

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ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

- Facilities that have an occurrence of 30% or more residents in the FFY with a diagnosis of severe mental illness (SMI) will be awarded an additional 30 points in that program year.
- The included SMI diagnosis and their respective MDS item set are **bipolar disorder** (I5900), **psychotic disorder** (I5950), **schizophrenia** (I6000), **post-traumatic stress disorder** (I6100), and **hallucinations** (E0100A).
- Number of facilities that met >30% threshold per year.
 - 2022 9 facilities
 - 2023 6 facilities
 - 2024 6 facilities

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MISSING DATA

Why data might not be publicly available?

- 1. The total denominator size throughout the FFY for the QM is inadequate; less than 20 stays.
- 2. If there is an identified coding inaccuracy related to antipsychotic use, CMS will suppress the LS AP QM data for 12 months. QSO-23-05-NH

- Solution:
- If 1 QM is missing in the four-quarter average, the available tier points will be used to prorate the point for the missing tier.
- If 2 or more QMs is missing in the fourquarter average, the state will request the data from the facility in the form of the Quality Measure Report from CASPER.
- If the requested data is not provided, the NF will not be included in the program for that year.

Calculation for Weighted Days

- Values are examples for demonstration.
 - 100 Medicaid Days per Tier\$1,000 total distribution
- Step 2 Calculate Base Dollar per day

Timing

- October 1 September 31 Data collection periods
- January February Publication of MDS data by CMS
- April Communication to facility administrators with MDS data, number of Medicaid days, and SMI percentages
- June Communication to facility administrators with all data points, tier placement. Payment requests submitted to fiscal.
- July Nursing Facility Incentive Program website data updated
